COACHING SUB COMMITTEE

1201 Primary Purpose

The purpose of the coaching committee is to assist coaches and potential coaches to obtain training, education and development.

1202 Composition of Committee and Frequency of Meetings

- 1 The Coaching Committee shall be chaired by the Chairman and consists of the following: Secretary, England Rugby Development Officers, RFU Area Training Manager, Representatives of HRR, Representatives from Education & Club Representatives.
- 2 The Group meets on a regular basis. These meetings can be held Virtually if holding a group meeting is not possible. (Online over a meetings platform)
- 3 Minutes will normally be issued within two weeks of the Meeting. The quorum for a Group meeting is six members of the Group. The Chairman is entitled to exercise a second or casting vote.

1204 Accountability

The Coaching Committee Chairman is accountable to the Game Development Chairman.

1205 Authorised to

- 1 Commit expenditure to meet the purposes within the budget approved by the Management Committee.
- 2 Plan and implement an annual coaching development programme that caters for coaches and teachers in the County.

1206 Tasks

- 1 To ensure that the activities of the Group are completed within the annual budget approved by the Management Committee.
- 2 To promote the individual development of coaches by arranging regular Coaching Seminars and CPD Sessions & an Annual Conference
- 3 To assist the County Office in distributing to Clubs the details of courses, education and development activities.
- 4 To enable the exchange of coaching information through meetings and networking opportunities.
- 5 To support and encourage Club Coaching Coordinators through support & networking.
- 6 To provide advice as required to any coach or potential coach.
- 7 To promote and encourage participation in the England Rugby Coaches Association (ERCA)
